to strengthen and support continuous transformation of public library services in Africa






What we do

Build capacity of Public Library systems in Africa (I)



- A project 'Digital skills and inclusion through libraries in Uganda' (Jan 2021 – March 2023)
- Working with 25 libraries across Uganda to enable youth and women to participate in digital society

Build capacity of Public Library systems in Africa (II)

Building on results of CPD/ToT programmes in Africa (2018-2020), organized **Virtual T-breaks** for the network of public librarians-trainers engaged and sharing good practice



Since launch in June 2021, **ten** Virtual T-breaks on different themes, e.g., online training resources, digital inquirer, microlearning, misinformation

Build capacity of Public Library systems in Africa (III)

Launched **EIFL-PLIP's Small Bites series.** So far, we produced three 5-6 min video lessons:

- Managing Workshop Expectations
- How to evaluate your library's training programme
- Outcomes of library programmes and services









Advocate for improved digital infrastructure in public libraries
