Accessibility

- Web accessibility ensures that websites and digital content are usable by all people, including those with disabilities (visual, auditory, cognitive, etc.).
- Information must be presented in ways users can perceive (e.g., alt text for images).
- Interface components must be usable (e.g., keyboard navigation).
- Content must be easy to understand and operate.
- Content must work across various devices and platforms.
- Meets legal requirements (e.g., ADA, WCAG).

Common features

- Text alternatives (alt text, captions)
- Keyboard navigation
- Color contrast
- Accessible forms
- Screen reader compatibility

Available options

- Improve the design of the repository, if possible (contrast, fonts, letter sizes, alt text, etc.)
- Complex solutions
- Paid tools (e.g. Userway)
- Free widgets

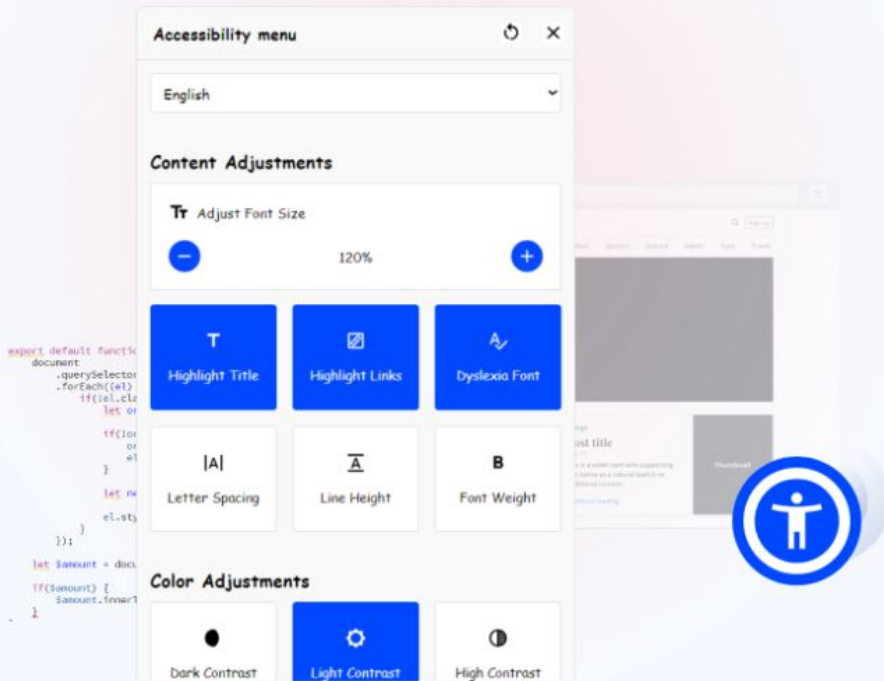

DAIS - Digital Archive of the Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts is a joint digital repository of the Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts (SASA) and the research institutes under the auspices of SASA.

The aim of the repository is to provide open access to publications and other research outputs resulting from the projects and other activities implemented by the SASA and its institutes, as well as to ensure their long-term preservation. DAIS responds to the requirements of national and international funding bodies to share the outputs of publicly funded research and is compliant to the Open Science Platform of the Ministry of Education, Science and Technological Development of the Republic of Serbia. The software platform, based on DSpace, enables easy and straightforward dissemination of metadata through international aggregators.

You may browse and search the metadata and download publicly available full-text files. If you want to browse and search authors and funding information, or to export metadata, you may also use the application Authors, Projects, Publications (APP).
